With only four botanicals it has a bold taste. It is served with a lime wedge.		
Hendrick's	£11.5
Peculiar flavour, infused with rose and cucumber. Served with fresh cucumber.

Rich and smooth, it's a classic London Dry, and one of only a small handful not to me made from concentrate. Served with lime wedge.		
Jensen Old Tom Gin	£11

Precursor to English gins, as well as being the origin of the phrase 'Dutch Courage', this genever style gin is served with cracked pepper.

Rich striking juniper with cardamom sweetness and Satsuma citrus breaking through, served with orange.		
Monkey 47	£15.5
A curious gin from the Black Forest in Germany. Made with 47 botanicals and bottled at 47%. Served with orange.		
Plymouth	£11
A rich, fresh aroma of juniper followed by notes of coriander and cardamom. Served with lime wedge.		
The Botanist Islay Dry Gin	£11.5
An unusual gin that contains no fewer than 31 botanicals, of which 22 are native to Islay itself. Unsurprisingly floral. Served with lemon thyme and grapefruit peel.		
Tanqueray 10	£13.5
As it is distilled with fresh fruit rather than only peels, it is served with fresh grapefruit wedge.		
Plymouth Sloe Gin	£11.5
Cassis coming through with cherry hints, this sloe gin is served with blackberry and raspberry.		
Opihr	£13
A London Dry Gin made with botanicals from along the traditional spice route, such as Indonesian Cubeb berries, Indian black pepper and Moroccan coriander. Served with black peppercorns.		
Pink Pepper	£13
Plenty of peppery aromas waft up, spicy but sweet at the same time. These touches are well balanced with cinnamon and clean, herbal notes. Served with pink peppercorn.		
Pothecary	£13
A pleasantly soft style of gin, with a little oiliness and the aromatic notes of lavender and citrus. Served with grapefruit peel and rosemary.		
G'Vine Floraison	£13
Fresh and floral, refreshing yet round and smooth, when the air is filled with fragrance of blossoming vine flowers. Served with edible flowers.		

Roku	£13.5
This expression is made using a selection of botanicals, including six Japanese botanicals provide a whistle-stop tour of the four seasons served with lemon peel. Served with ginger slice.		
Slingsby	£12.5
This is a citrus-led gin with juniper and green tea flavours served with grapefruit peel.		
Slingsby Rhubarb	£12.5
Our rhubarb flavoured pink gin features an initial sweetness of rhubarb and raspberry followed by a bitter tang from the pink grapefruit citrus base served with dry rhubarb.		
Cotswolds	£12.5

This is an authentic Dutch genever. Composed of 53% malt wine (triple-distilled rye and malted barley) and 47% grain spirit, plus juniper, citrus peel, star anise, liquorice and coriander botanicals. Served with orange slice.		
Portobello navy strength	£13
It features the same botanical recipe as the original, though with a touch of English sea salt. Served with lime wedge.		
Stawberry & Balsamico	£14
Inspired by ancient Rome, the botanicals include rosehip, celery and pomegranate. Served with orange peel.		
Ki No Bi	£16.5
Ki No Bi Gin has been made using a rice spirit base and ingredients - the likes of yuzu, hinoki wood chips, bamboo leaves, green sansho and gyokuro tea. Served with ginger slice.
